Institute of Development Studies Kolkata invites applications for the post of Director. The details of qualifications, responsibilities, entitlements and procedure of selection of the Director are given below. Age limit for the applicants will be same as those which are applicable to Pro-Vice-Chancellors' position in the universities of West Bengal (i.e. 65 years of age). Applications or nominations from eminent academicians along with full details of CVs with complete educational record, details of teaching, research, publications, policy interventions and names of two referees (with complete postal address and e-mail id) should be sent to the *President, Institute of Development Studies Kolkata, DD 27/D, Sector I, Salt Lake, Kolkata 700064* by a registered post or e-mail [office@idsk.edu.in](mailto:office@idsk.edu.in) by **19 March 2018**.

### **Qualifications, Responsibilities, Entitlements and Procedure of Selection of the Director:**

An eminent academician having excellent academic record with PhD in any branch of social sciences with at least ten years of experience of research and teaching in recognized academic institution along with adequate experience of academic administration shall be selected for the post of Director. The candidate must also have an adequate number of research publications.

The Director shall be the principal executive officer of the Institute and the head of all its academic and administrative activities. He /she shall be a full-time academician appointed for a period of five years, who shall also simultaneously be offered a substantive academic position which he/she shall have the option to occupy when he/she ceases to be the Director. The Director shall be responsible for the administration of the affairs of the Institute within the framework of the Regulations of the Institute.

The Director may be a super-annuated person or an in-service person.

In case of a super-annuated person, he / she will be offered an honorarium of an amount to be determined by the Governing Council plus reimbursement of medical bills or medical insurance premium up to a limit of Rs.20,000/- per year.

In case of an in-service person he/she will be entitled to the scale of pay enjoyed by the Pro-Vice-Chancellors of state universities of West Bengal plus the allowances as admissible.

In both the cases the Director is entitled to standard prerequisite such as car for official use and the telephone at residence.

The Director shall be appointed by the Governing Council on the basis of the recommendation of a Search Committee of three members. The Chairman of the Search Committee is nominated by the President of the Institute, one eminent social scientist is nominated by the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal and one eminent social scientist is nominated by the Governing Council of the Institute. The Search Committee shall recommend a panel (in alphabetical order) of more than one name but not more than three names for the post of the Director for consideration of the Governing Council. The decision of the Governing Council shall be final. The Search Committee may exercise options in considering persons other than those who apply.
