

ANINDYA SEN: BRIEF CV

Anindya Sen retired as Professor at the Indian Institute of Management Calcutta (IIMC) which he had joined in 1998. From 1990 to 1997, he was a Professor at the Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research, Mumbai, India and Dean of Graduate Studies (1992-93 and 1995-96). At IGIDR, he was Chairman, Local Arrangements Committee for The India and South-East Asia Meeting of the Econometric Society, Dec 19-21, 1992 (this was the first meeting of the Econometric Society in India and witnessed the participation of three Nobel laureates).

He also taught at the Department of Economics, University of Calcutta during 1979-84. He acted as Pro-Vice Chancellor, School of Social Sciences, Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, Bangalore, during 2021-2023.

He was Visiting Professor at the School of Business and Management, American University of Armenia, and at the Department of Economics, University of Notre Dame, USA.

He obtained his BA degree from Presidency College, Calcutta, and his MA degree from the University of Calcutta. He holds a Ph.D. degree from the University of Southern California, USA. His fields of interest are Industrial Organization, Theory of the Firm, Regulation, Law and Economics, and Strategic Management.

At IIM Calcutta, he was Dean (Program Initiatives) during 2006-2008 and Dean (Academic) during 2012-15. As Dean (Academic) he successfully carried through the AACSB and AMBA accreditation processes and initiated the EQUIS accreditation process. He was a Faculty Representative to the Board of Governors, IIM Calcutta, 2016 –2018.

He has been appointed Member of the Technical Advisory Committee for Social Sciences Division, Indian Statistical Institute, and External Member, Faculty Council of Arts, Jadavpur University.

As Director in-charge, Indian Institute of Management, Ranchi, November 2014-February 2017, he was instrumental in obtaining the land on which the current campus is situated from the Government of Jharkhand, in lieu of the land allotted earlier which was unsuitable for setting up a campus for various reasons.

He has authored and edited several volumes. He was General Editor for a cluster of books on Economics and Development in the Oxford India Short Introduction series. Currently he is the Series Editor for two series being published by Routledge, one entitled "Contemporary Themes in Business and Management", and the other "Routledge Focus on Management and Society".

He has published in both Indian and international journals and contributed chapters to a number of volumes.
